The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 22.02.2020, under Sections 420, 408 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner, who was an employee of the complainant, had embezzled some money. He, however, contends that the matter has been settled.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 16.03.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
