The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 05.12.2019, registered under Sections 307/34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 27.02.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the matter stands settled between the parties and in fact there is another FIR bearing No.70 dated 14.11.2019, registered under Sections 459, 307, 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala, in which also, the compromise has been effected.

CASE HEARD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has been settled between the parties. It is further submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 27.02.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is also submitted that the petitioner has not misused the concession of bail for the last 1½ years.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
