By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to respondent No.2 to consider and promote the petitioner to the post of TGT English w.e.f. the date his juniors have been promoted i.e. 30.07.2018. Consequential benefits have also been prayed for.

Reliance has been placed upon judgments passed by this Court in *CWP No.12143 of 2016 "Suresh Chander and others vs. State of Haryana and others"*, decided on 12.09.2018, *CWP No.23209 of 2018 "Sharmishtha Yadav vs. State of Haryana and another"*, decided on 04.07.2019 and *CWP No.10054 of 2016 "Mahesh Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others"*, decided on 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that a legal notice dated 16.01.2021 (Annexure P-6) has been served upon the respondents and he would be satisfied if the same is decided within fixed time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.K.S.Brar, Addl.Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the limited prayer which is sought and since the legal notice which has been served two months earlier and the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose would be served by calling the opposite side to file reply in response thereto.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 16.01.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the benefits are not made out, a reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
