Case taken up through video conferencing.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition since the petitioner intends to file a petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act against his wife Jeevanjyot Chauhan, arrayed as respondent No.5 in this petition, but some order be passed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with the observations that petitioner may file petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act against

his wife, respondent No.5 – Jeevanjyot Chauhan statedly residing separately from him along with her parents.

As regards, the order to protect life and liberty of the petitioner, respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh is directed to look into the representation submitted by the petitioner, copy Annexure P1, assess the threat perception to him and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law.
