Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial enquiry into the complaint/representation dated 03.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) and take legal action thereon. A further direction has been sought for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into his representation dated 03.01.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran – respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 03.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 03.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
