Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4 is the husband of the petitioner, who fell in bad company and came in association with respondent No.5, who is a criminal type of person and that petitioner's husband i.e. respondent No.4 and respondent No.5 had been indulging in criminal activities. It has been submitted that petitioner's husband i.e. respondent No.4 went missing in the year 2016 and in respect of which she lodged a complaint in the Police Station on 21.04.2016. However, respondents No.4 & 5 have re-appeared now all of a sudden and have been threatening her and are trying to take forcible possession of her buffaloes and other domestic articles on which the petitioner is dependent for her livelihood and for raising her children.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and

to dispose of the representation dated 06.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 06.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
