This is the Fourth petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No. 121 dated 26.11.2018, registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural.

A perusal of the record shows that the application for bail pending trial was dismissed by this Court by a detailed order dated 22.9.2020. This Court does not find any ground to take a different view. Hence, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial is dismissed. However, the prosecution is directed to expedite the evidence before the trial Court.

However, pursuant to the previous order passed by this Court, the State has filed the status report qua the factum of marriage of the daughter of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. The report substantiate the assertion of the petitioner that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 5.8.2021. Being mother of the girl getting married, the petitioner

would be required for certain ceremonies to be performed at the time of the marriage. Hence, it would not be unjustified to grant the petitioner ad interim bail for a period of two weeks from the date of actual release of the petitioner.

Let the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of two weeks on her furnishing bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Needless to say that the petitioner would report back to the concerned Magistrate or to the Jail authorities on 15th day at 10:00 a.m. of her release.
