The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to get detenue- Jasandeep Kaur, minor daughter of the petitioner, released from illegal detention of respondents No.5 to 10.

As per office report, respondents No.5 to 9 have been duly served but none has appeared on their behalf. However, notice issued to respondent No.10 has been received back unserved as he is out of station.

Learned State Counsel has, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, submitted that the matter has been compromised between the private parties and custody of minor daughter Jasandeep Kaur has been handed over to the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has acknowledged these facts and submitted that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.
