Through the present writ petition, the petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to consider and take a final decision on representations dated 10.02.2020; legal notice dated 19.02.2020 and representation dated 15.06.2018 in a time bound manner. Further, they sought directions to the respondents to remove illegal encroachments on both sides of Railway Crossing No. A-29 and also to shift HT/LT lines, electric Poles and Transformers on both sides of Railway Crossing and to provide Road dividers.

A bare perusal of the prayers show that the writ petition is, primarily, in the nature of public interest litigation and the petitioners do not have any personal legal right in the matter. Therefore, it cannot be entertained as such. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file public interest litigation, if considered appropriate.
