GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the merits and veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana that in case the petitioner moves an appropriate application to respondent No.2 seeking security, the same shall be got examined expeditiously in accordance with law. In case, it is found that there is genuine threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, then necessary steps as warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

As far as the prayer of the petitioner for taking action on his representations dated 31.08.2021 and 18.01.2021 (Annexures P-1 & P-2 respectively) is concerned, it is directed that in case the petitioner moves an appropriate application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the Illaqa Magistrate, the Magistrate concerned shall dispose of the same in accordance with law at the earliest.

Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, for necessary compliance.
