Case taken up through video conferencing.

Apprehending dangers to their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9, petitioners – Bakhshish Singh, Amrik Singh and Pargat Singh have approached this Court by way of filing the instant criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, craving issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar and Station House Officer, Police Station, Majitha Road, District Amritsar to protect their lives and liberty as well as that of their family members at the hands of such private respondents.

According to the petitioners, they had submitted representations to the police authorities, copies of which are Annexures P1 and P2, without evoking any response.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to look into their representations Annexures P1 and P2 and then to take the necessary action in the matter.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents No.1 to 3 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representations Annexures P1 and P2, assess the threat perception to the petitioners and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law at the earliest.
