Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of direction to the officials respondents not to harass the petitioner and his wife at the instance of respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the son of the petitioner namely, Amandeep Singh was in love affairs with Deepika i.e. daughter of respondent No.6 namely, Sonia. They ran away and sought protection to their life and liberty by filing CRWP-735-2021 before this Court. Vide order dated 27.01.2021, the said petition was disposed of by this Court with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to decide the representation moved by the petitioners therein and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty was perceived. It is further submitted that even in the FIR got registered by respondent No.6, the son of

the petitioner was granted ad-interim bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 18.03.2021.

It is still further argued that despite the said factual position, respondent No.6 in connivance with the official respondents, is harassing the petitioner. In this regard, the petitioner has already moved a representation to respondent No.2 on 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-2), but till date no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Without commenting on the merit of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to decide the representation dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) moved by petitioner, within a period of one month after receiving the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
