This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0147 dated 07.06.2020, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 302/452/336/506/148/149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is identically placed to his co-accused Angrej Singh, who has been admitted to bail by this court vide an order passed on 19.02.2021, he having filed CRM-M-36588-2020.

It is seen that Angrej Singh in turn was admitted to bail on the ground that learned State counsel appearing at that stage could not deny that his case was similar to Manjit Singh @ Tinku, who had already been admitted to bail by this court (co-ordinate Bench) on 30.10.2020.

Learned State counsel submits that however, as a matter of fact, even recovery of a motorcycle was made from the petitioner as was the case with Angrej Singh, which seems to have not been pointed out to this court at that time.

Be that as it may, since Angrej Singh has already been admitted to bail, with the prime accused (Chandan and Shambu) who are actually stated to have shot the deceased, being in custody, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
