This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take legal action against respondent No.4, as he is demanding Rs.5 lacs from the petitioner by blackmailing and threatening her on the pretext of uploading her photographs on internet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner being a divorcee came in contact with respondent No.4 in October, 2020 through internet and developed friendship with him. He contends that since respondent No.4 was having relationship with many other women, therefore, the petitioner severed her relations with him. According to him, respondent No.4 is now threatening the petitioner and in this regard, a representation dated 22.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) has already been given to SSP, Moga for taking action against respondent No.4, however, no action has been taken upon the same, therefore, the petitioner has approached this Court. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

The arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner have been refuted by the learned counsel for respondent No.4 on the ground that the petitioner had already borrowed Rs.4 lacs from respondent No.4 and when he demanded back his money, she has falsely implicated him by giving false representation against him to the SSP, Moga.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and considering the representation dated 22.01.2021, this Court finds that the averments made by the petitioner are not supported with convincing material. Since, the alternative remedy is available with the petitioner, therefore, this Court is not inclined to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
