Present petition has been filed by the petitioners apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued on 26.02.2020 and Mr. Prince Sharma, Advocate, for Mr. Jaspreet Cheema, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents No. 5 to 7 and submits that this Court has been misled as petitioner No.2 is already married and has not taken divorce from his first wife.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 5 to 7 further submits that the present marriage is illegal. Learned counsel submits that the private respondents are law abiding citizens and have no intention of violating the law and will never interfere in the life of the petitioners in any manner much

less threatening the life and liberty of the petitioners.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Once, the private respondents have undertaken before this Court not to interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

As this Court is not commenting upon the marriage of the petitioners, the private respondents, in case, have any grievance in the said aspect, will be free to avail appropriate remedy for the same.
