AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 38 dated 21.2.2021, under Sections 308 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Pehowa.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Anmol Singh. The allegations are that on 21.2.2021, a quarrel took place between the complainant and the accused, including the petitioner. The petitioner gave an iron rod blow on the head of the complainant, the reason for the incident was a previous altercation between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of false implication, the petitioner is in custody since 22.2.2021, investigation is complete, no recovery is to be made. He further relies upon the fact that in his deposition the complainant has not supported the case of the prosecution.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Mahant Pal opposes the prayer for bail. She fairly submits that the complainant was examined and has not supported the allegations against the petitioner. She further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Considering the facts and circumstances in totality, especially that the investigation is complete, challan stands presented, no recovery is to be made, the complainant has been examined and petitioner has no criminal antecedents, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
