Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 3 to 5, who are the police officials and are calling the petitioner to police station.

It is stated in the petition that on an earlier occasion, an FIR No. 93 dated 06.08.2016, under Sections 10, 11, 13, 17, 19, 38, 39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 read with Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Chabbewal against four persons and the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender. Later on, out of the four accused, who faced trial, three were convicted on 02.04.2019 and one person namely Bikramjit Singh @ Bikka was acquitted. Thereafter, the petitioner surrendered before the Court and was granted regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 06.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-50968-2019 and he is facing trial. It is further stated in the petition that petitioner was

summoned by Superintendent of Police (D), Hoshiarpur without any reason.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required in any proceedings as he is already facing trial in aforesaid FIR and in routine sometimes, the police conducts surveys about the people who are involved in unlawful activities, which is a routine exercise of the police and no harassment was caused to the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.
