Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.283, dated 09.11.2020, having been registered at Police Station Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauthansh Sanrakshan and Gauthamvardhan Act, 2015.

Learned State counsel submits, on instructions, that the petitioner has joined investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

Though a reply has also been submitted by the DSP, Yamuna Nagar, dated 29.10.2021, stating that the petition be dismissed, however in view of the fact that the investigating officer himself stating that the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is not required, the order passed on 14.09.2021 is made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

The affidavit filed by the DSP, dated 29.10.2021, is ordered to be taken on record.
