SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.86 dated 29.10.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, (Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

On 02.03.2020, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is a Datar blow on the right hand of the complainant. He has further referred to the cross complaint lodged by Kuldeep Kaur, on 03.11.2019 (Annexure P2) pertaining to the same incident in which Kuldeep Kaur has alleged that she was dragged by the complainant and injuries were inflicted on her by the husband and son of the complainant.

Notice of motion for 25.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would be present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M- 1231-2020.”

Interim order passed in CRM-M-1231-2020 has been made absolute by an order passed on even date.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Kewal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
