As per the status report filed on behalf of the State by way of affidavit of Mr. Sukhjinder Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North Jalandhar, the condition of the applicant/petitioner is stated to be stable. The relevant report, as reproduced in para 4, is extracted below:

“As per record available, pt. Varundeep Singh 35 years M s/o Jaspal Singh r/o 747/101 New Santokhpura, Jalandhar was admitted in Civil Hospital, Jalandhar on 19.11.2021 vide CR No.1210000664 with Chief complaints of pain abdomen and vomitings. He was K/C/O/HIV on ART, as per record. He was investigated and treated at Civil Hospital, Jalandhar and discharged on 26.11.2021 in a stable condition with advised of oral medicine and also advised to continue ART. His condition as of the today cannot be commented upon as he was discharged in stable condition.”

In view of the aforestated position, this Court does not find any ground for any further extension of interim bail to the applicant/petitioner. The application, as such, is dismissed.

Needless to mention, in case there is any change in circumstances, it shall be open to the applicant/petitioner to approach this Court again.
