This is second petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.283, dated 01.07.2020, registered under Sections 177/409/420 IPC, at Police Station Ambala Cantonment, where there are allegations of misappropriation/fraud having been played upon the railways amounting to almost Rs.8 crores. Some railways officials have now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to face trial. The petitioner's brother, who is the main accused, is on the run and has not been apprehended as on date. In case the petitioner herein is released on regular bail, there is every likelihood of his tampering with the evidence or influencing the witnesses. Therefore, at this stage, there is no ground made out for grant of regular bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
