Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.165 dated 12.9.2019 registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

By virtue of the order dated 9.7.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
