1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents having married against the wishes of their families.
2. Learned State counsel while referring to the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3/State has drawn the attention of this Court to the statement of petitioner No.1 – Shubham (Annexure R-1), wherein he had stated that now with the consent of both the families, their marriage has been solemnized on 24.07.2021. Similarly, petitioner No.2 – Jyoti has also stated that they have now performed marriage with the consent of both the families and that she is residing happily with her husband.

3. Learned State counsel has also referred to the statements of Narender Chawla, father of petitioner No.2 and Kiran Chawla, mother of petitioner No.2, who have also stated that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners.
4. In view of the aforestated position, it is apparent that there is no imminent threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. The petition, as such, is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
