By way of this petition, the petitioner seeks the indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to appoint him on the compassionate ground under the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019, while averring that his father had been working with the respondent as permanent Farm Mate but unfortunately, he died on 19.01.2020 and his mother had pre-deceased his father and though, he has already served legal notice dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent in this regard but the same has not yet been decided.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

would be satisfied if the respondent is directed to look into and deal with/decide his said legal notice (Annexure P-4) within some specific time frame.

Keeping in view the afore-discussed limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the matter in hand, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Managing Director, the Haryana Co-operative Sugar Mills Limited, to look into the said legal notice of the petitioner dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) and to decide/deal with the same in accordance with law/relevant Rules/Policy, by passing a speaking order thereon, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
