This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 57 dated 10.2.2021, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 201, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the only role attributed to the present petitioner is that he uploaded digital signatures of the complainant which were then utilized by Sachin son of Radhe Kishan. The main allegations are against said Sachin that he misused signatures of the complainant. Counsel would further submit that the petitioner is in custody since 19.2.2021 and nothing is to be recovered from him. It is contended that he is duly authorized by the National Stock Exchange of India Limited to upload documents and digital signatures on the web.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that the petitioner herein was instrumental in uploading digital signatures of the complainant which were subsequently misused by said Sachin, who is yet to be arrested.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

Keeping in view the fact that the only allegation against the petitioner would be of uploading of signatures of the complainant and as on date, there is no such allegation against him of misusing the said signatures. As all allegations seem to be against said Sachin, I deem it appropriate to allow the petitioner benefit of bail, at this stage. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
