After hearing arguments for some time, when this Court showed its disinclination to interfere, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.6 lakh before the first appellate Court, which would be kept in a fixed deposit, and subject thereto order under challenge before the first appellate Court may be stayed.

Learned counsel representing the respondent, on instructions from his client, does not object to the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the petitioner. In view thereof, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.6 lakh, within a period of two weeks, before the first appellate Court. Subject to said deposit, operation of the judgement and decree dated 21.7.2018 passed by the trial Court shall remain stayed till the final disposal of the first appeal.
