Prayer in this second petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents as petitioner No.1 wants to live with petitioner No. 2 against the wishes of the private respondents.

The first petition, filed by petitioner No. 1, bearing CRWP-2422-2021, was dismissed as withdrawn on 10.03.2021.

A perusal of the present petition shows that petitioner No. 1 was married to respondent No. 4 Nishu Bidlan on 27.02.2008 and one male child, who is aged about 1 ½ years, was born out of the said wedlock.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during subsistence of the aforesaid marriage, petitioner No. 1, without obtaining divorce, has started living with petitioner No. 2 as there was a matrimonial dispute between petitioner No. 1 and respondent No. 4, therefore, they have approached the police authorities to provide protection, however, no action has been taken.

Be whatsoever, on the face of it, the dispute seems to be a

matrimonial dispute between petitioner No. 1 and respondent No. 4 and the present petition has been filed just to get a seal of this Court on the so called Live-In-Relationship of the petitioners, which cannot be termed to be legal as petitioner No. 1 is living in adultery with petitioner No. 2 as her marriage with respondent No. 4 has not yet been dissolved.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
