This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct impartial and fair enquiry in FIR No. 16 dated 8.2.2018, under Sections 436, 379, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

The allegations are that the petitioners have been falsely implicated.

Learned counsel for the State puts in appearance on advance notice. On instructions from ASI-Major Singh, she submits that challan against six of the accused in the FIR have been presented. The petitioners were nominated later on and the enquiry is pending with Deputy

Superintendent of Police-Harpreet Singh.

learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedies in
accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievances, if any.
