This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.323 dated 22.04.2019 under Sections 504, 506 & 511, 384 (added later on) Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, District Karnal. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 13.03.2020, whereby, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Mr. Abhayjeet Singh, Advocate has appeared for the complainant by filing vakalatnama. The same is taken on record. He seeks some time to place on record certain documents which according to him are necessary for just decision of the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the

investigation. Learned State counsel states that the petitioner be directed to do so.

Under such circumstances, the petitioner is directed to join investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within 5 days from today and render all sort of cooperation. The petitioner has to surrender his Passport before the Investigating Officer, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. The next date of hearing is fixed as 30.4.2020. If, in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned counsel for the complainant may place on record the documents which he wants to file by moving application in the Registry in the meanwhile.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Dharam Pal does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being. He further states that the final report also stands filed.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.03.2020 is made absolute.
