Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of some matrimonial discord, his wife i.e. respondent No.5 lodged FIR No.331 dated 09.10.2018 at Police Station City Rajpura, under Sections 406/498-A/323/354/354-A/34 IPC against the petitioner. It has been submitted that despite lodging of said FIR, respondent No.5 was not content with the same and in order to harass the petitioner, has been filing one frivolous complaint after another and that he apprehends serious threat to his life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.5 and other members of her family.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and to examine the alleged threat perception and to

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dispose of the representation dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law expeditiously.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
