Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.89 dated 06.02.2021, under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that two persons riding on a motorcycle had snatched the mobile phone of the complainant. He also contends that two co-accused have been arrested and the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused. The petitioner is 24 year old and does not have any criminal antecedents.

This Court, by the order dated 18.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vijender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
