The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation into the matter in which the petitioner has been cheated by respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount of money about Rs.7 lacs was deposited in his account and fraudulently withdrawn by private respondents. Learned counsel further submits that despite the representation dated 19.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) having been made to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib i.e respondent No.2, no action has been initiated against the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 19.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 19.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
