This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 339 dated 29.10.2020, under Sections 22(C), 27A (Act No. 61) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. It is argued that alleged contraband has been recovered from one Simrandeep Singh @ Soni, who in his disclosure statement named the present petitioner and the said disclosure statement would not be admissible in law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail by contending that Simrandeep Singh @ Soni was apprehended with vast quantity of narcotics but is not in

a position to dispute that the petitioner herein has been named by said Simrandeep Singh @ Soni, who is in custody.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that alleged contraband has been recovered from one Simrandeep Singh @ Soni, I deem it appropriate to allow the petitioner benefit of bail, at this stage. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
