In the present petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenge has been made for quashing the election of the office bearers of respondent no.8-Society, which is stated to have been conducted by respondent no.7 in an illegal manner. Admittedly, the petitioner along with others has already approached respondent no.3 under Section 102 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), for setting aside the election, which is stated to have been held on 21.02.2021, which is clear from the perusal of Annexure P-4 dated 12.03.2021.

In such circumstances, the petitioner cannot be permitted to open up another front of litigation once an alternative remedy is provided under Section 102 of the Act. It is open to him to pursue the remedy, which he had already availed.

No case is made out for interference by this Court.
