per the reply, it is stated that on an enquiry, it was found that Pippal Singh has given a statement to ASI/Incharge Police Station Sadar Jagraon, that he has 83 acres of agricultural land and when he visited his farm house, he found that the agricultural instruments and domestic articles were stolen and on enquiry, he came to know that the said theft has been committed by Manjit Singh, Tarsem Singh, Harpartap Singh, Sarvan Singh, Gurcharan Singh, Gurdeep Singh in connivance with Amarjit Singh @ Pappu, Baljinder Singh @ Khati, Joginder Singh and Paramjit Singh @ Pamma and, thereafter, the FIR No.88 dated 19.04.2017 under Section 380 IPC has been registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon. Later on during the investigation, 04 persons namely Manjeet Singh, Tarsem Singh, Harpartap Singh and Sarvan Singh, were found innocent and thereafter, Gurdeep Singh and Joginder Singh have been arrested and challan qua them has been presented.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for redressal of his grievance, if any.
