The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 and 5 in view of representation dated 06.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) made to respondent No.2 i.e Director General of Police, Police Headquarters Section 9, Chandigarh and respondent No.3 i.e the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 and 5 trespassed into the house of the petitioner and forcibly took away his car and scooter after giving him threats of false implication in criminal cases. Learned counsel further submits that a representation qua the alleged occurrence was made to respondents No.2 and 3 but no action has been initiated thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, A.A.G.,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 06.03.2021(Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 06.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
