This common order shall dispose of above noted two petitions
as they arise out of the same FIR.

Prayer in these petitions, filed under Section 439 of the Code of

Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail to petitioners in case FIR No. 119 dated 419, 420, 120-B of the IPC (Sections 465, 467, 471 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the FIR has been registered on a complaint given by complainant Kulwant Singh (petitioner in second petition), wherein it is stated that petitioner Jaswant Singh @ Kulwant Singh has obtained job by producing the certificates of complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submit that both the petitioners are real brothers.

It is further submitted that both the petitioners are not involved in any other case; are in judicial custody for the last more than nine months; offences are triable by the Court of a Magistrate and conclusion of trial is likely to take a long time.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificates and could not dispute the fact that both the petitioners are real brothers; they are in judicial custody for the last more than nine months and they are not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petitions are allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned.
