Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner claims to be owner of commercial vehicle bearing registration No.HR-63-B-1119.

Instant petition has been filed seeking a Mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to issue to him a NOC in respect of vehicle for Nagpur (Rural).

Counsel submits that the application for such purpose has been submitted but till date no decision thereupon has been taken and the same is pending.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without opining on the entitlement of the petitioner to be issued a NOC pertaining to the vehicle in question, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to

respondent No.2 i.e. DTO (Jhajjar), Bahadurgarh, Haryana to examine the application dated 16.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) and to process the same strictly as per law. A final decision in the matter as regards issuance/declining of the NOC be conveyed positively within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.
