This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-10) issued by the Punjab Small Industries and Export Corporation, whereby request for waiver of an amount of Rs.81,647/- has been declined.

We find that the petition is set up on facts which are totally jumbled.

Writ petition is at the hands of one Sudeep Kumar. The letter of allotment placed on record and appended as Annexure P-1 is in favour of one Smt. Rekha Garg and pertaining to allotment of Plot No.E-52, Growth Centre, Pathankot. The impugned order is in relation to a different plot i.e. Plot No.E-51, Industrial Growth Centre, Pathankot.

We called upon the counsel to resolve such riddle.

He is unable to put forth the actual factual premise.

Withdrawal of the writ petition is sought with liberty to file a petition with correct and better particulars.

Petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
