The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is second petition for grant of bail to the petitioner pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no. 178 dated 08.08.2019 registered under Section 22, 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Section 379, 411, 483 IPC added later on, at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The first petition was dismissed by this Court on 21.11.2019, with the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.178 dated 8.8.2019 registered under Sections 22, 25 of NDPS Act at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 270 grams of intoxicating powder. Petitioner as per the order passed by learned Court of Sessions is involved in 4 more cases, including three under the NDPS Act.

Hence, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.”

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is involved in as many as 4 cases, including the present one, under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, no ground to grant bail is made out.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
