1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.827 dated 29.5.2017, under Sections 323, 354, 406, 420, 467, 498-A IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 09.12.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements

recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Shekhar Rana, Virat Singh, Kaushalya Devi and Pradeep Kumar and also of complainant Neha Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Neha Singh in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

5. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.

6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.827 dated 29.5.2017, under Sections 323, 354, 406, 420, 467, 498-A IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
