Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 13.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) and 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 13.10.2020 to the State Director, National Crime Investigation Bureau, Chandigarh and on 11.08.2020 to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, copy of which are available on the file as Annexures P/4 and P/3 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 – Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to look into and decide representation dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
