1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.207 dated 23.10.2020 at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind, under Sections 324/341/506/34 IPC.
2. The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner had inflicted 4/5 knife blows to the complainant.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been amicably resolved amongst the parties, as the petitioner and the complainant are residents of the same locality and the respectables of the area had prevailed in the interest of maintaining cordial atmosphere in the locality.

4. Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the petition while submitting that the petitioner is not only named in the FIR, but specific allegations have also been levelled against him. Learned State counsel has, however, informed that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 9 months.
5. On the other hand, learned counsel representing the complainant has, however, endorsed the factum of compromise and has submitted that the complainant has no objection in case the petitioner is released on bail.
6. In view of the aforestated position wherein the petitioner is stated to be behind bars since the last about 9 months and the petitioner as well as the complainant are also stated to have amicably resolved their issues and had entered into a compromise, the instant petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
