The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint case No. 49-I dated 18.07.2017, registered under Sections 3(1) (P) & (Q) and Section 3 (2) (ii) of the Schedules Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 Amendment Rules, 2016 read with Sections 209 and 120-B of the IPC, 1860, pending in the Court Ld. JMIC, Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 23.03.2021, passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court and has misused the concession of bail.

In nutshell, the case against the petitioner, as per the complaint filed by respondent No.1- Babu Lal Meena, who is present in person, is that the petitioner has been harassing him by filing false cases against him which were

decided in favour of the complainant. It is further submitted that the petitioner had misrepresented the facts in the previous litigation.

Be whatsoever, considering the fact that the petitioner, in compliance of the order of this Court, is regularly appearing before the trial Court and is facing the trial, the present petition is allowed and order dated 23.03.2021 is made absolute.
