Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 14.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) and 19.02.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 14.02.2021 to Station House Officer, Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar and on 19.02.2021 to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar, copy of which are available on the file as Annexures P/2 and P-3 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 19.02.2021 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
