By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty as he apprehend danger at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner entered into an agreement to sell and being an owner of the land measuring 44 kanal 3 marla, received a sum of Rs.12 lakh. According to him, the vendees are pressurizing the petitioner to return the earnest money. He contends that the petitioner being a senior citizen submitted his representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib on 10.03.2021, but till date officer has not taken any action.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, considering the above prayer made by the learned counsel, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to relegate the petitioner to respondent No.3. Resultantly, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation of the petitioner and take action, if required, in accordance with law.
