AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to know the status of FIR No. 2 dated 7.1.2021, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the petitioner committed suicide and the FIR is of January, 2021 but no challan presented till date by the police. The grievance raised is that an application was made on 13.3.2021 through post which has not even been considered.

Considering the facts of the case that there is a suicide note, it can safely be stated that in such a case FSL report would be required with regard to the suicide note. The period prescribed under Cr.P.C. for filing the challan has not expired. Instead of availing the remedies in accordance with law, the petition is filed merely to know status of the investigation.

No ground is made out for interference by this Court.
The petition is dismissed.
