Second petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.196 dated 29.08.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

This Court while issuing notice of motion on 03.03.2020 passed the following order:-

“Contends that on account of some miscommunication with the Counsel of learned trial Court, petitioner could not appear on 10.02.2020 and that led to the cancellation of bail bonds and surety bonds. Further contends that petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 26.03.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the proceedings before learned trial Court and he be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that matter has been compromised between the parties and as such, petition is rendered infructuous.
