The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a writ of habeas corpus for ensuring release of detainee namely Mery Silpa Singh wife of the petitioner and producing her before this Court.

While issuing notice of motion on 22.03.2021, this Court had directed respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh and respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Nuh, District Nuh to ensure presence of detainee Mery Silpa Singh before this Court through video conferencing.

Learned State Counsel has, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, submitted that due to particulars of the residential address of the petitioner and respondents No.4 to 6 as mentioned in the memo of parties being incomplete respondents No.2 and 3 could not ensure presence of detainee Mery Silpa Singh before this Court.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he could not contact the petitioner and has no instructions to appear in the case any further.

The petitioner has not appeared in person or through any other Counsel. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed in default for non-prosecution.
