This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4 and to take action on representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 09.03.2021 to Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City, to look into and decide representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
